Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another’s speech.’

“So the Lord scattered them abroad from there over the face of the whole earth; and they stopped building the city. Therefore its name was called Babel, because from there the Lord confused the language of the whole earth; and from there the Lord scattered them abroad over the face of the whole earth.”
